


THE TIME MACHINE

- ⚙️ **The Reality:** Human consciousness moves intermittently along the Time-Dimension from cradle to grave.





Fig 1.1: The Instantaneous Cube Paradox

Operational Risk: Intervening Substance


Stopping the machine involves the risk of jamming the pilot molecule-by-molecule into an obstacle occupying the same space.

Climate

No shops


No commerce

The Incident: The Time Machine is dragged inside the hollow bronze pedestal of the White Sphinx. The Eloi react with horror when the Sphinx is mentioned.

Observed Anomalies Lato Bold

- Circular wells with deep shafts.
- Sound of thudding machinery underground.
- Ventilation towers creating heat mirages.
- Sightings of 'Ghosts' (white figures) in the twilight.

Profile: The Morlocks



Lato Regular / Light


Habitat: Subterranean. Access via ventilation wells.

Physicality: “Bleached, obscene, nocturnal Things.” Cold to the touch. Large pinkish-grey eyes adapted for darkness.

Behavior: Carnivorous. Photophobic (fear of light). Highly mechanical aptitude.

Observation: Encountered in a ruin and confirmed via descent into a shaft.

Hypothesis II: The Great Divergence




The Capitalist and the Labourer pushed to biological extremes.

Descent into the Underworld




Environment: Absolute darkness. Thrumming machinery. Stagnant air.



The Discovery: The Morlocks are not servants; they are predatory. The Traveller is touched by soft hands and discovers the red meat.


Defense Mechanism: The Morlocks retreat from the light of a match.

The Truth: Cattle and Rancher



The dynamic is not Master/Servant, but Rancher/Cattle. The Eloi are preserved and fattened. The Morlocks harvest them during the 'Dark Nights' of the new moon.

The Site: A ruined museum of paleontology and technology. The death of history.




Salvage Inventory

The Night of the White Terror




Context: Trapped in the woods at night with Weena.

The Weapon: Fire. The Traveller lights the forest to ward off the photophobic Morlocks.

The Outcome: The fire becomes uncontrollable. The Morlocks are blinded. Weena is lost in the chaos.

The Trap of the White Sphinx



The Setup:

The bronze doors are open, the machine cleaned and oiled.

The Ambush:

The doors slam shut, trapping the Traveller in the dark with the Morlocks.

The Escape:

A desperate struggle. The Traveller strikes a match (requiring the box) to find the levers. He engages the machine, barely escaping into the future.

The Further Vision: Entropy



Headline:

Millions of years hence.

The Sun:

Stationary (tidal locking) and expanding into a Red Giant.


The Earth:

Cooling. Snow and ice encroach from the poles.

The Fauna:

Giant crustacean life forms. A desolate, silent ecosystem.

The Terminal Era




30 Million Years Hence.

The Evidence:


The machine is damaged.

The Epilogue




- **The Disappearance:** The Traveller vanishes again three years later, never to return.

The Warning of the Time Machine




Biological
